

G Adventures: Camping in Scenic Alaska and Denali

Day 1 Anchorage

Arrive at any time. Included Activities: Arrival Day and Welcome Meeting

Day 2 Anchorage/Valdez

Today is a long travel day, but there will be a number of stops along the way to stretch your legs and take in scenery like the Worthington Glacier and Thompson Pass. Included Activities: Worthington Glacier Visit Transport: Private Vehicle (5.00-6.00 hours, 480km)

Day 3 Valdez

Valdez is a quintessential Alaskan coastal town surrounded by impressive mountains, and a great place to explore. Opt to hike Thompson's pass, kayak beside one of the world's largest tidal glaciers or catch a glimpse of salmon spawning (in season). The crashing glaciers and towering Chugach Mountains rising from the sea make Valdez absolutely picturesque.

Day 4 Valdez/McCarthy

Travel into Wrangell-St Elias National Park, staying in the small historic town of McCarthy. Surrounded by more mountains and glaciers than anywhere else in Alaska, every direction has a spectacular view. Transport: Private Vehicle (6.00 hour(s), 233km)

Day 5 McCarthy

This national park is the largest in the US, roughly 25% larger than Switzerland, and is the convergence of three mountain ranges. Included Activities: Explore Wrangell-St Elias

Day 6 McCarthy/Tangle Lakes

Drive through Copper River Valley en route to Tangle Lakes, checking out the fishwheels (used for salmon) along the way. Camp under the stars in the remote Alaskan wilderness. Transport: Private Vehicle (8.00 hour(s), 290km)

Day 7 Tangle Lakes/Denali National Park and Preserve

Enjoy a scenic drive along the Denali Highway, stopping for photos along the way. In the afternoon, reach Denali National Park, known for its diversity of wildlife and the highest mountain in North America, Denali, formerly called Mt McKinley. Bask in the awesomeness of this vast wilderness.

Transport: Private Vehicle (6.00 hour(s), 257km)

Meals: (1B, 1L)

Day 8 Denali National Park and Preserve

Enjoy plenty of time to explore and hike Denali NP. Discover the dynamic glaciated landscape providing large rivers, countless lakes and ponds, and unique landforms which form the foundation of the ecosystems that thrive in Denali with some hikes in the area. Enjoy picnic lunches and revel in the awesomeness of the park. For those that do not want to hike, options include rafting on the Nenana River, a visit to the dog-sled kennels run by the park rangers or opt to take a scenic flight over Denali. Included Activities: Denali National Park Visit Scenic Shuttle Bus to Eielson Visitor

Center

Day 9 Denali National Park and Preserve/Anchorage

Travel back to Anchorage. Trip ends on arrival to Anchorage. Included Activities: Departure Day (Activities) Transport: Private Vehicle (4.00-5.00 hours, 370km)
